This work will explain what a medicine cabinet is, its importance, the elements that make it up and the proper use of each one.

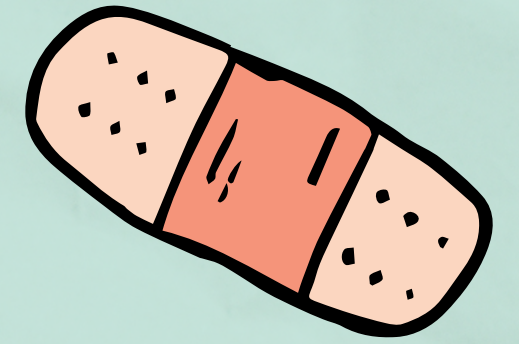










What is a medicine cabinet?.

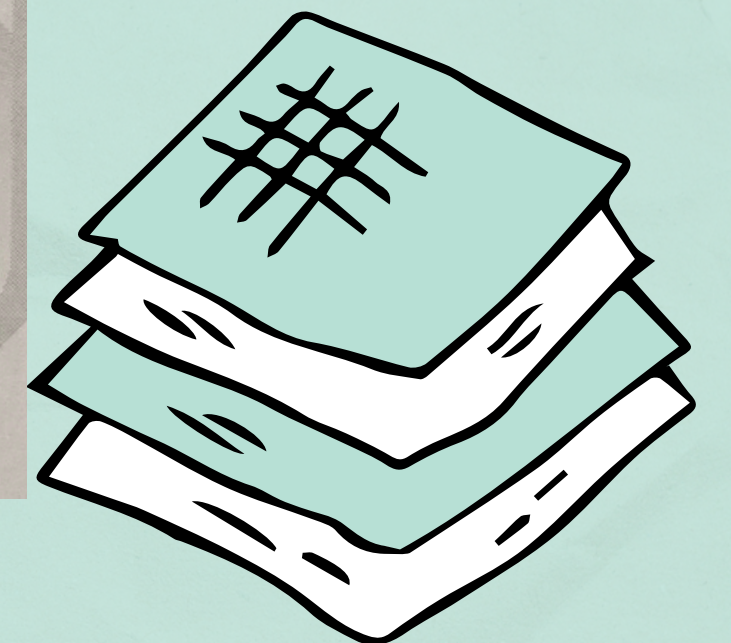

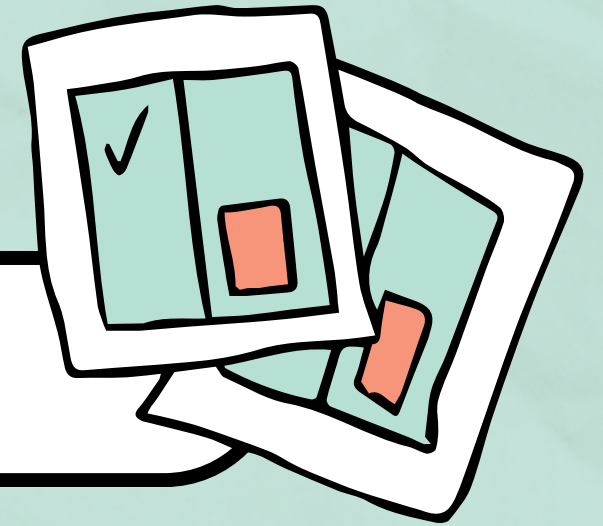


GLOVES

Gloves are used to protect your hands from blood, germs, or any other type of contamination when you help someone who is injured.

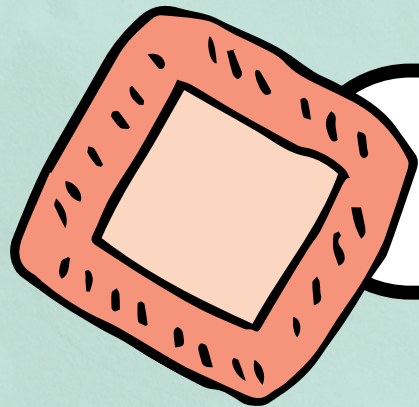
MASK

A mask is used to cover your mouth and nose to prevent the spread of infections and to keep the area sterile while giving first aid.



SCISSORS

Scissors are used to cut bandages, medical tape, or even clothes around a wound if necessary.



FLASHLIGHT

A flashlight is used to provide light in dark places or during emergencies at night when visibility is low.

COLD GEL

Cold gel is used to reduce pain, swelling, or inflammation caused by minor injuries or burns.

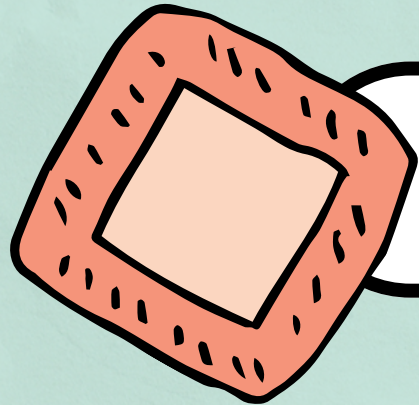
ELASTIC BANDAGES

Elastic bandages are used to wrap and support injured muscles or joints, such as an ankle or wrist.



THERMOMETER

A thermometer is used to check a person's body temperature to know if they have a fever.



CREAM

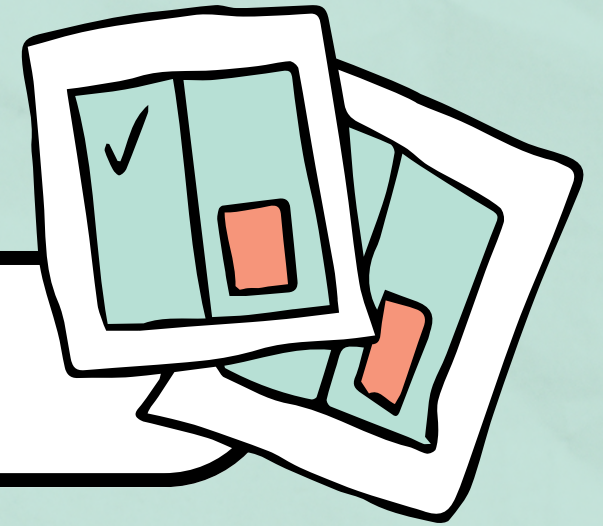
Cream is used to soothe the skin and help with minor burns, rashes, or insect bites.

Pills are used to relieve pain, reduce fever, or treat minor health problems when necessary.

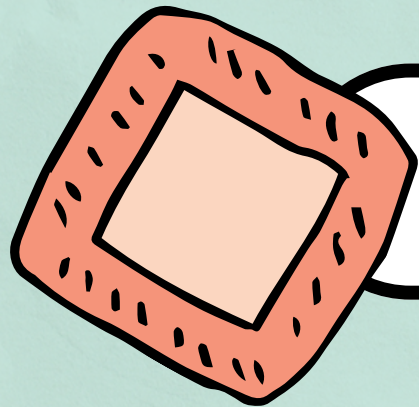
ANTIBIOTIC

MANUAL

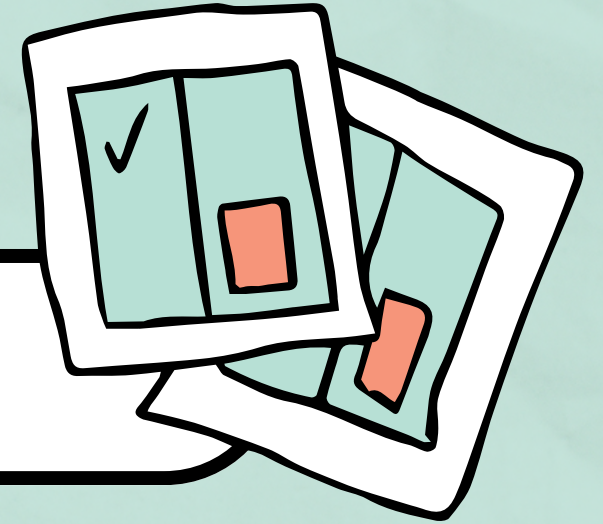
The first aid manual is used to guide you on how to act in an emergency and give the correct first aid steps.

Tweezers are used to remove splinters, glass, or other small objects from the skin carefully.

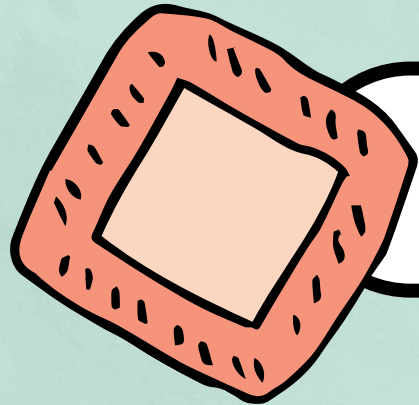
BLANKET

MICROPORE

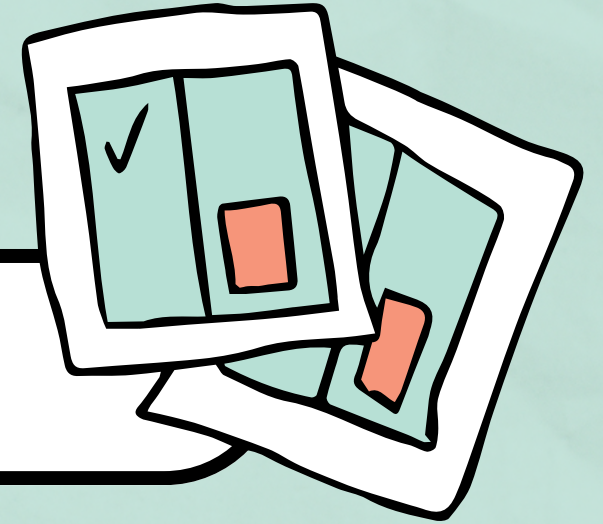
Micropore tape is used to secure bandages or gauze on the skin gently without causing irritation.

Paper clips can be used to keep first aid instructions or emergency notes together in your kit.

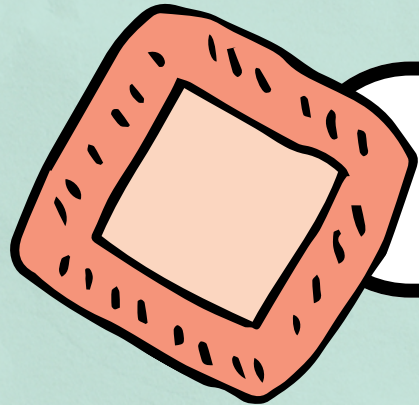
FIRST AID KIT

ADHESIVE BANDAGES

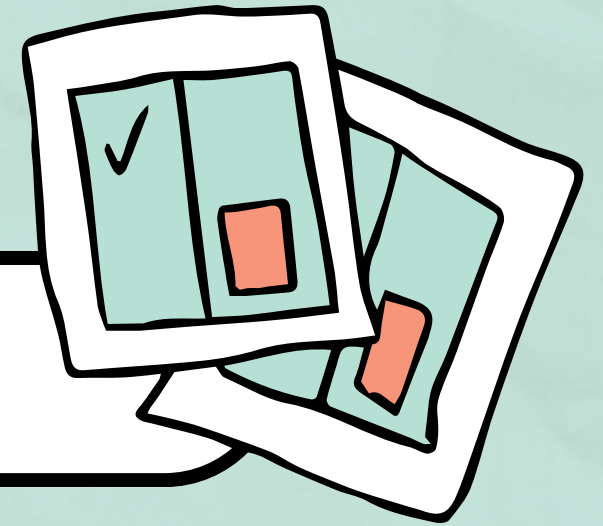
Adhesive bandages are used to cover small cuts, blisters, or wounds to protect them from dirt.

Sterile gauze is used to clean wounds safely and absorb blood or other fluids.

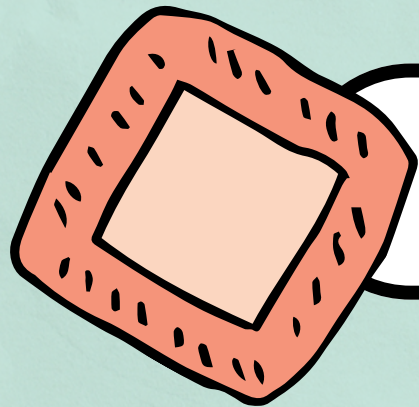
COLD COMPRESS

Aspirin is used to relieve pain, headaches, or reduce fever and inflammation.

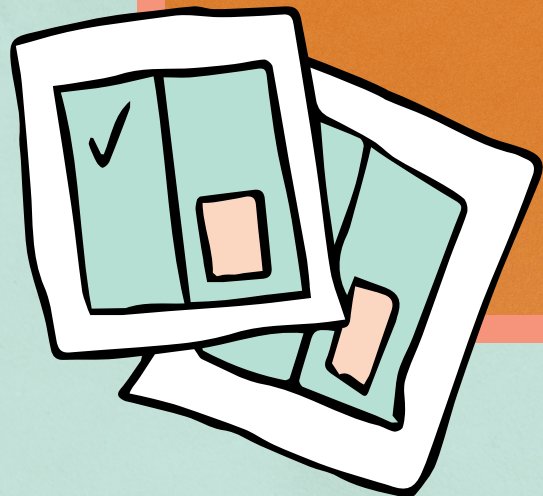


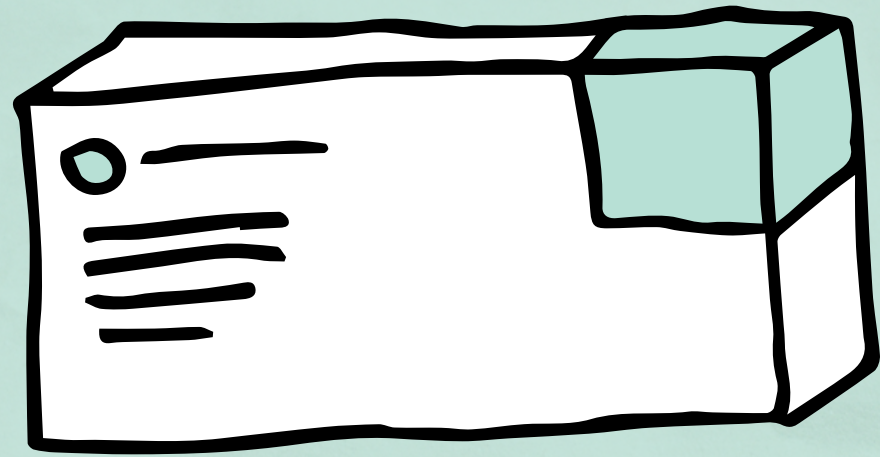
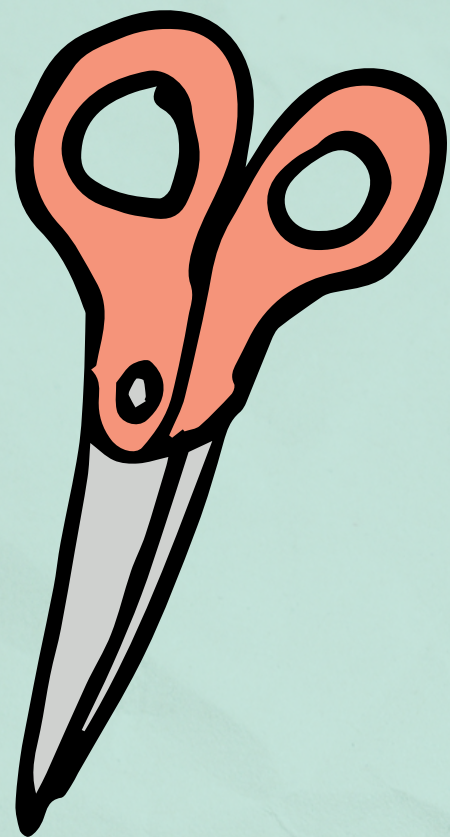
TRIANGULAR SALES

Triangular bandages are used to make a sling to support an injured arm or shoulder.

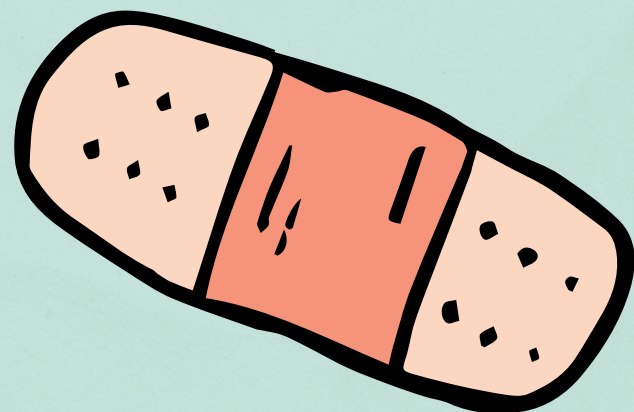
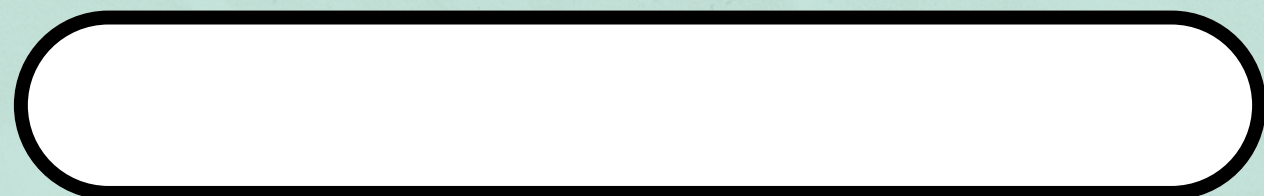
Conclusión
